

AN 'EXEMPT' MINOR CAN BE ON LICENSED PREMISES

WHO IS AN EXEMPT MINOR?

An 'exempt' minor is a minor who:

- Lives on the premises (in Qld only)
- Is an employee, or receiving Training or Work Experience (documented)
- Is conducting lawful business (eg a supplier or an entertainer)
- Is eating a meal
- Is with a parent or guardian
- Is with a responsible adult who is ~10yrs older, **and** responsibly supervising the minor
- Is attending a function
- Is at a Club and the Club rules allow it
- Has special approval from OLGR (is attending a 'blue light' disco)

WHAT CAN AN EXEMPT MINOR DO ON LICENSED PREMISES?

- Can enter the venue
- Can approach the bar to buy chips or soft drinks
- Can watch non-adult entertainment
- Can order and consume a meal
- Can work at the venue in any capacity
- Can attend a bona fide Function

AS LONG AS THE REASON FOR HIS 'EXEMPT' STATUS REMAINS CURRENT

SO CHECK...

- Is his guardian still nearby?
- Is he still eating?
- Is he still working?
- Is the function still in full swing?
- Does he live here?

WHEN HIS REASON FOR BEING 'EXEMPT' IS GONE – HE MUST ALSO BE GONE!
